Tuesday: April 9

- Read: Luke 17:11-19
- Jesus is great! He has ALL authority to heal!
- Jesus is good! The lepers ask for mercy and receive it!
- Jesus is gracious! He never casts aside ANYONE who comes to Him!
- Do I believe this?

Wednesday: April 10

- Luke 17:11-19
- The response of the one leper who comes back is humble gratitude.
- He worship Jesus with a loud voice. He falls on his face in worship. He gives thanks.
- What should I be thankful for today? How would God ask me to worship?

Thursday: April 11

- Luke 17:20-37
- Since Jesus' return is sure and unpredictable, we must live expectant lives that are not too attached to our possessions and pray for the kind of faith that will endure to the end.
- The kingdom of God is both present and future.
- The coming of the kingdom will be both sudden and obvious.
- His return brings both judgment and salvation.
- What we receive depends on if we are prepared.
- Attachment to our possessions is a prime danger to our preparation.

- Proverbs 12
