# Baggage: Part 3 – Action expresses priorities!

## Monday: April 22

- Read: Luke 19:1-10
- Who am I in this story? The rich man? The crowd? The religious people? The tree?
- What must I do to become the tree?
- Who am I being a tree for today? This week? This year?

### Tuesday: April 23

- Read: Luke 19:11-27
- Who am I in this story? A servant? One of the people? An enemy of God?
- Am I fully accepting Jesus' authority over my life? It's all or nothing!
- What areas of my heart are hardened toward the authority of God?

# Wednesday: April 24

- Read: Luke 19:28-37
- What has the Lord given to me that He has need of?
- Am I being fully obedient to His call? What's stopping me?
- What one step could I take today to move toward full obedience?

### Thursday: April 25

- Read: Luke 19:38-44
- The city gathered and praised Jesus, but Jesus still wept over the city. Why?
- Read aloud 3 times the end of vs. 44 after the word "because"!
- Are you recognizing that God is calling to you? What will you do about it?

#### Friday: April 26

- Read: Luke 19:45-48
- This moment was recorded to tell us of a significant event. Why is it important?
- The Court of the Gentiles is where anyone not a Jew could come and give their lives to God. It is a place for them to purchase an animal for sacrifice and to begin honoring God with their whole lives. The people selling the animals for sacrifice wouldn't accept any offering they brought and would charge exuberant prices from the Gentiles to get right with God. This is what too many people do with their fellow sinners. They make it difficult for them to ever see or experience God because they don't love fellow sinners well!
- Who am I blocking from knowing God because I am keeping God to myself?

### Saturday: April 27

- Read Luke 20 in preparation for Sunday!
- Especially focus on Luke 20:41-47! Who do you say Jesus is?
- Who SHOULD I invite to attend church with me tomorrow?
