- *What should I start praying for that I need God to resurrect in me?*

Friday: May 3

- *He found them to be hypocrites, self-righteous, and blind to the real needs of people.*
- *If Jesus were to stand before me today and measure / judge my life, what would he find?*
- *Would I be more like the religious teachers of the Law?*
